His academic background includes graduation from Winchester College, one of England's most distiguished public schools, Princeton University (B.A.) and Stanford University (M.A.), as well as the Certificate for one year of studies at the Institut de Sciences Politiques in Paris and doctoral work at the University of Buenos Aires. He studied art at the Academie de la Grande Chaumiere in Paris, He exhibited his work throughout the world and was elected in 1967 a lifetime member (societaire) of the Paris Salon d'Automne. Mr. Reid had a fluent knowledge of Spanish, French and German, he read, wrote and spoke Quechue, the language of the Incas, Which he began to study formally in 1973 at the Maryknoll Language Institute in Chochabamba, Bolivia. Renowned author of several books on Pre-Columbian Textile Art.
